5. List of consents, permissions or licenses required under other enactments for the purpose of the power sought in the Order, containing details of the name of the persons from whom the consent cognition or license is required, the date of the application of such persons or the grant, or refusal of such consent, permission or license (as the case may be) had reference numbers (if any) of such applications (Rule 10(2)(e))
6. The Applicant's Statement of Environmental Information (Environmental Statement) (Rule 10(2)(f))
7. Plans and sections showing the works (Rules 10(3)(a) and Rule 12 (1-3))
8. Estimate of costs of carrying out the works authorised by the proposed Order (Rule 10(3)(b))
9. The Applicant's proposal for funding the cost of implementing the Order (Rule 10(3)(c))

10. Request for a direction under Section 90(2A) of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (Rule 10(6))
11. Book of Reference and land plans showing land that is prepared to be subject of compulsory acquisition, etc (Rule 10(4) and Rule 12(5-10))
12. Plans, comprised in the plans referred to at 7 above (showing ways, paths, tracks etc, which are the subject of extinguishments or diversions) ( Rule 10(5)).
